Grapes: 100% Pinot Gris

Area of Production: Oregon, United States

Appellation: Willamette Valley

Vineyard: LaVelle

Age of Vines: Planted in 1969

Altitude: 600 feet

Soil: Bellpine

Farming practices: Organic and Biodynamic

Yeast: Native

Fermentation: Gentle pressing followed by a 24 hour maceration and three weeks on lees with regular stirring

Aging: 50% in stainless steel and 50% in neutral oak barrel

Production: 400 cases produced
