Poetry offers notes of fresh raspberry, black fruit, new leather, and aromatic herbs. The palate is bright and lively with flavors of mixed berries, forest floor, and baking spices. An effusive wine framed by laser beam acidity.

Style: Still red

Grapes: 100% Pinot Noir

Area of Production: Oregon, United States

Appellation: Willamette Valley

Vineyard: Lower Long Tom AVA, Dundee Hills AVA, Laurelwood District AVA, and Ribbon Ridge AVA

Altitude: 600 feet

Soil: Marine sediment, volcanic, and loess

Farming practices: Organic and Biodynamic

Yeast: Native

Fermentation: 20% whole-cluster with pump-overs (some punchdowns depending on the particular fruit)

Aging: 9 months in 5% new and 95% neutral French oak barrels

Production: 1000 cases produced
