Pretty floral aromas of honeysuckle and vanilla on the nose, with an element of ripe yellow peach. Rich and weighty on the palate with creamy tropical fruit flavors and well-balanced minerality.

Area of Production: Rioja Alta

Vineyards: La Loma and Mingortiz

Varietals: 75% Garnacha Blanca,
25% Viura

Age of Vines: 45-75 years old

Altitude: 534 m above sea level

Soil: Calcareous and clay

Fermentation: Grapes settle for 24 hours after harvest, then are fermented in 500 L French oak barrels

Aging: 10 months on the fine lees in 500 L French oak

Production: 2,600 bottles
