WOOD VALLEY CHARDONNAY



Aromas of crushed stone and briny minerality lead, later offset by pear, preserved lemon and grapefruit, and lanolin. The wine is smooth and soft, finishing with a bright acidity.

Style: Still white

Grapes: 100% Chardonnay

Area of Production: Napa Valley, California

Appellation: Sonoma Valley

Vineyard: Wood Valley Vineyard

Altitude: 400 feet

Soil: Forward-Kidd Complex

Farming practices: Sustainable

Yeast: Native

Fermentation: Whole-cluster press with the juice left to sit overnight in stainless steel, followed by fermentation in neutral barrel

Aging: Neutral barrel for one year

Production: 98 cases produced
